7. Entry

The fee for entry in each event shall be:

Senior and Junior - \$75.00. Cadets and Rookies - \$75.00.

Multiple entries will reduce by \$10.00 per entry to a maximum of \$20.00.

Second and subsequent family member entry will reduce by \$10.00 per entry to a maximum of \$20.00

The date and time for close of entry shall be Entries close at 11:00 a.m. on the day of racing

Minimum licence requirement is Grade D Provisional, subject to class licence restrictions

8. Minimum Entries

The minimum number of entries per class shall be 8. If insufficient entries are received for a class, classes may be cancelled or combined at the discretion of the Organiser.

The promoter reserves the right to cancel or combine classes.

9. Format of Racing

One Carby /qualifying session of 2 laps of orange flashing light for Carby then 6mins of Green light for qualifying for all classes.

Cadets & Rookies

Heats 1, 2 and 3 8 laps Pre-Finial 10 laps Final 14 laps

Seniors & Juniors

Heats 1, 2 and 3 8 laps Pre-Finial 10 laps Final 14 laps

Grid positions for first three heats will be determined by qualifying time, fastest to the front.

Grid positions for the Pre-final will be determined by points accumulated from the three proceeding heats with the lowest accumulated points to Grid 1, second lowest to grid 2, and so on. In case of a tie at the conclusion of the third heat, the grid position will be determined by the higher finishing position in heat 3.

The winner of the event shall be the driver/entrant with the lowest accumulated points from all. **All points count**.

In case of a tie in points at the end of the final the winner will be determined as per 2014 rule book.

The point system to be used shall be:

 $1^{st} = 0$ points

 $2^{nd} = 2$ points

 $3^{rd} = 3$ points and so on with one point added for each place.

A DNS, DNF or DSQ shall result in points added equal to the number of entrants in that class plus 1(one).

14. <u>Fuel</u>

CALTEX Vortex 98 PULP is the control fuel for this meeting and must be purchased from Caltex Service Station, 100 Hastings River Drive Port Macquarie, (Northern exit to Port Macquarie) from pumps 1-4 and 7-8 and must be used on Saturday 10th May and Sunday 11th May 2014 inclusive.

Competitors must supply their own fuel. Random samples of competitor's fuel will be taken during this meeting and tested for conformity to samples taken from the supplier Between these dates.

REMINDER: Fuel tanks and drums should be empty and clean prior to being used for fuel purchased for this meeting.

Due to the Fuel Storage Laws, all competitors must provide their own fuel dump Facility. Port Macquarie Kart Club Inc WILL NOT provide fuel dumping facilities for Any competitors.

15. Engine Sealing

Refer to 2014 Rule Book.

Drivers are responsible to ensure engine seals are attached at all times.

21.Pit Paddock/Parc Ferme Area Control

- 1. No vehicles are permitted in the Pit Area. Trailers are permitted within the allocation area of 3m x3m only and all ropes/stays are to be within the allocated Area, vehicles to be parked in designated parking areas. Pit/paddock marshals Will be responsible to manage and control the pit/paddock. Failure to follow their Directions will see charges being laid.
- 2. No smoking or welding in pit/paddock areas.
- 3. No dumping of fuel on site.
- 4. No dumping of Tyres on site.
- 5. Scooters, skateboards and pushbikes are not allowed in pit/paddock areas. (Disabled transport excluded from this rule.)
- 6. All power leads are to be secured above ground in a safe location. (Per WH & S guidelines)
- 7. No tyres to be left on site. Drivers are to dispose of their own tyres.

A Historic Kart track demonstration will not be conducted at this meeting per 2014 Rule book.

17. Dog Policy

No dogs are permitted at Pacific Park unless on a lead

18. Smoking Policy
