d)	Karts can be retrieved as instructed by the Clerk of the Course and/or Grid Marshal only.

a)	No animals allowed anywhere within the facility with the exception of Guide Dogs and companion dogs on leads.
b)	No dumping of Fuel or Tires, please make own arrangements.
